**Congratulations Julie Cornelius, associate pastor of Waukee Christian Church, earned her Pastoral Care Specialist certificate through a two-year program of the Des Moines Pastoral Counseling Center!!**

**Pastoral Care Specialist Program completed after two years, 20 topics (one addressed each month), and 20 reflection papers written. Each month there was a guest speaker who shared insight into their specific expertise. It was a lot of work. I spent many hours monthly gaining knowledge on the chosen topic. Examples of topics covered were Addictions, Codependency, Loss and Grief, Trauma, Depression, Spirituality of Aging, Care for Dying, Renewing of Spirit, and others.**

**You may have wondered at 'this season of life' why I would have taken on such a challenge? *It was for you and I.* It will enhance my work with this community of believers and others in the greater community. I obtained a nucleus of people with a common interest as a support system during difficult challenges. Someone not emotionally involved can often more easily access the situation 'as a whole'. Besides expanding my knowledge, I can better define my limitations on these topics with understanding of whom to turn to, for the next step of care.**
