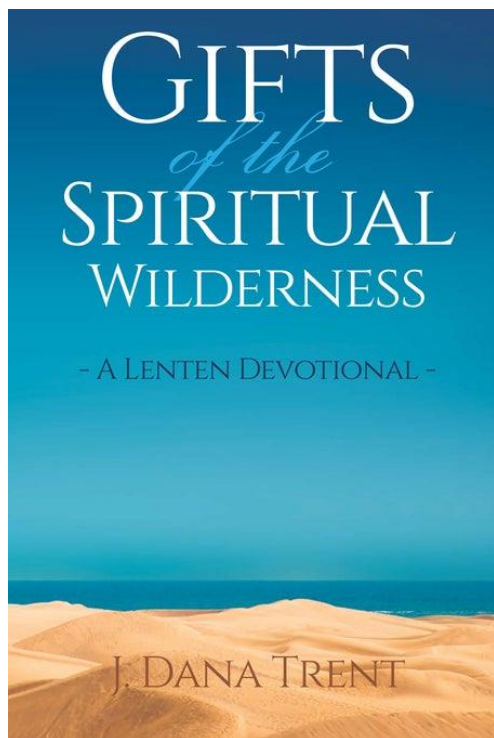
Dear Church Family,
